

ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY SERVICES

To help people with disabilities that have difficulty with access at either their workplace or home, ReTech Associates provides consultation services to help sort out the issues of access and accommodation. A board certified Assistive Technology Practitioner provides this service. Services available include the following:

Assistive Technology Initial Assessment. This assessment is done at the person's home or workplace and is a prerequisite for developing a plan for environmental changes to the home or workplace. This evaluation provides the referring agent with the opportunity to obtain information regarding the specific needs and problem areas in the home or work environment.

Work-site Modification Consultation. This service may be provided following the initial assessment and can include the collection of work samples, introducing appropriate Assistive Technology (AT) solutions and evaluating competing technology options to enhance the worker's performance. The result will be a detailed plan and recommendation to the referring agent to introduce specific

AT devices. Leasing, purchasing and funding strategies for the acquisition of the AT device is part of this service. Coordination, training or technical assistance for the person with a disability, their families, professional, employers or other services provides is also facilitated.

Home-Site Modification Consultation. This service is provided to families and agencies and follows the AT Initial Assessment. An assessment of the home-site and the need for and facilitate necessary modifications which may include installation of ramps, widening doorways, and modification of vehicles to accommodate the individual with disabilities. This program has been particularly beneficial to families caring for their child with developmental disabilities.
